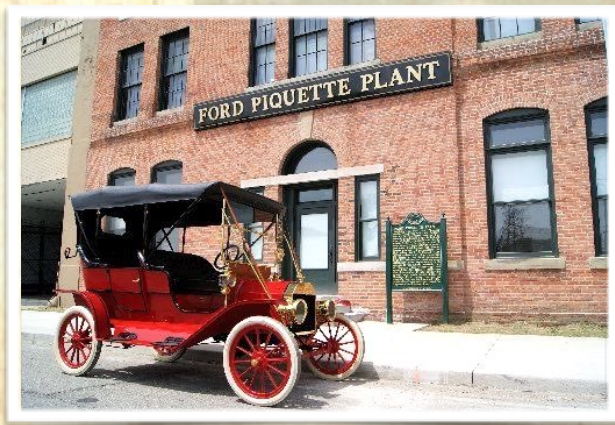


Our Mission

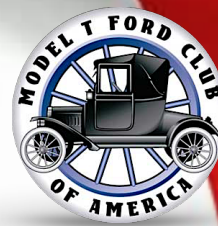

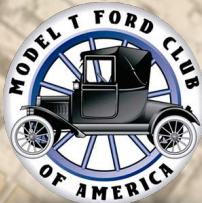
